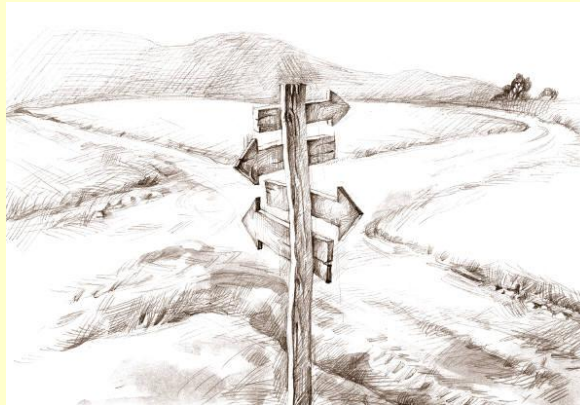

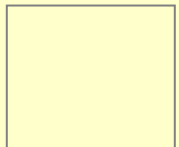

From the East via Turnpike: Take Turnpike westbound to Gettysburg Exit 236 (old Exit 17), follow Route 15 North to Route 581 West to I-81 North, Follow I-81 North to Wertzville Road Exit 61; turn left at the first traffic light at end of ramp, at second light turn left onto Good Hope Road, at first road turn left onto Woodland Drive. PSATS is at right at the end of Woodland Drive.

From the North via I-81: Take I-81 South to Wertzville Road Exit 61; turn left at the first traffic light at end of ramp, at second light turn left onto Good Hope Road, at first road turn left onto Woodland Drive. PSATS is at right at the end of Woodland Drive.

From South via I-83: Take I-83 North to 581 West exit towards Camp Hill , merge onto PA -581 West exit onto I-81 North towards Harrisburg, take the Wertzville Road Exit 61; turn left at the first traffic light at end of ramp, at second light turn left onto Good Hope Road, at first road turn left onto Woodland Drive. PSATS is at right at the end of Woodland Drive.
