Responsibilities:

- Manage and administer Farm to Families, an affordable produce purchase program that offers yearround food and nutrition education to participating residents. Tasks would include processing orders, distributing items, weekly communication with participants, and extensive promotion and outreach to connect the program to more neighbors in need.
- Support NKCDC's Sustainable19125-34 program through event planning, resource collection, and connecting residents to ways to live sustainably and affordably.
- Organize and update the department's resources as they relate to healthy food access, and build relationships with partnering organizations to improve access to healthy food according to the recommendations of NKCDC's North of Lehigh Neighborhood Revitalization Plan.
- Represent NKCDC at community meetings through its service area.
- Conduct bi-weekly canvassing of targeted neighborhood areas to ensure consistent communication and promotion of NKCDC events.
- Provide event planning, staffing, and other support for programs such as the Neighborhood Advisory Subcommittee and the Somerset Neighbors for Better Living.
- Other duties as assigned.
