The successful candidate will assist with the reorganization and evolution of the Community Planning Section to support the Executive Director, LVPC and the region. The ideal candidate will be a contemporary planning professional who demonstrates the ability to understand and appreciate the complex social, economic and environmental factors that sustain the Lehigh Valley community. He/she will be an empowering manager who can effectively foster cohesiveness across functions and sections. An adept relationship builder, the ideal candidate will also have extensive experience interacting with a highly engaged community. The Director of Community Planning is anticipated to provide strong leadership to a variety of communities in urban, suburban and rural contexts, specifically, in the areas of:

- Comprehensive and community planning
- Revitalization and sustainability planning
- Regional growth management
- Ordinance development and implementation planning
- Regional and local comprehensive plan development and implementation
- Subdivision and land development review oversight

ABOUT THE LEHIGH VALLEY PLANNING COMMISSION, TRANSPORTATION STUDY + REGION

The Lehigh Valley Planning Commission is the official planning commission for Pennsylvania's Lehigh and Northampton Counties and the third most populated region in the Commonwealth. The LVPC also, serves as the Metropolitan Planning Organization, or transportation and infrastructure planning agency for the same areas. The Lehigh Valley is strategically located on the eastern border of Pennsylvania, north of the Philadelphia region and west of the New York-New Jersey metropolitan statistical area. The fastest growing region in the Commonwealth, the Lehigh Valley is known for a high quality of life, recreational and cultural amenities, as well as, its variety of housing and communities from rural to urban. The region is unique, in that it is home to three cities and 59 other communities including dense urbanized boroughs, old and new suburbs, cross-roads villages and rural landscapes.

section work plan

- Directs the administration of Lehigh and Northampton County subdivision and land development, subdivision and ordinance review processes
- Interprets and applies applicable state, county, and local codes, ordinances, regulations, standards, specifications, policies and procedures pertaining to planning, zoning, land development, and land use
- Presents applications to the LVPC, local government, planning, zoning boards and commissions, and citizen groups
- Ensures accurate and consistent application of policies and regulations
- Collaborates with the Transportation, Environmental, Administrative Sections of the LVPC, as well as, the Lehigh Valley Transportation Study Technical and Coordinating Committees and Lehigh Valley Planning Commissioners to further community planning functions
- Collaborates with Lehigh County, Northampton County, Lehigh Valley communities and other organizations to further LVPC objectives
- Prepares and delivers community engagement services to further regional planning and support the equity ethos
 of the LVPC
- Prepares planning documents, model ordinances and projects in conjunction with the LVPC Team
- Directs and manages the region's largest public data center, including leading scenario planning efforts
- Directs personnel management/performance in section
- Collaborates with the LVPC team to promote regional and community planning services including seeking out and capitalizing on new opportunities
- Prepares and presents to a variety of audiences and in a variety of formats
- Manages the Lehigh Valley Government Academy and Certified Citizen Planner Programs and identifies and presents planning training courses to the community
- Mentors and coaches Community Planning Team, supporting an environment of learning and innovation
- Arranges and participates in community consultations, meetings and events
- Represents the Executive Director at meetings or on projects
- Other duties as assigned
